MEMORANDUM FOR All Competitors

SUBJECT: Texas Composite Shooting Teams

1. Effective 1 January 2008, the following policy will be in effect concerning membership on the Texas Composite Shooting Teams (Regional and Winston P. Wilson National Guard Championship Competitors).
2. The top three teams in each discipline are invited to TRY OUT for Regional and National competition as a result of their scores in the annual Adjutant General's State Matches.
3. The top twenty shooters in the rifle and pistol disciplines will be invited to TRY OUT for Regional and National competition as a result of their scores in the annual Adjutant General's State Matches.
4. To be selected for Regional and National competition, the shooter must attend scheduled training. Excuses will be limited to extreme circumstances only.
5. It is the responsibility of the competitor to learn the schedules, dates and equipment required for training sessions. Attendance is mandatory unless emergency circumstances occur.
6. Overall scores, physical condition, appearance, military bearing and knowledge of the weapon system will be determining factors in selection for Regional and National teams.
7. The State Marksmanship Coordinator, Assistant State Marksmanship Coordinator and NCOIC will select team members based on the above-mentioned requirements. A review board consisting of the State Marksmanship Coordinator, Assistant State

Marksmanship Coordinator, NCOIC, and two competitors of the discipline concerned will address protests. The decision of the board will be final.
